Monday to Saturday journeys from University Hospital of North Tees to Stockton between 0742 (1017 Saturday) and 1822 will operate 2 minutes earlier, arriving into Stockton High Street 1 minute earlier. The off-peak winter timetable will be introduced and continue in operation until Saturday 13 April 2019. The frequency of buses between Whitby and Scarborough will be reduced to hourly each day, with the last Monday to Saturday departures 50 minutes earlier, at 1845 from Whitby and 1955 from Scarborough. The first Sunday journeys between Whitby and Scarborough will operate an hour later, at 0936 from Whitby and 1050 from Scarborough. The 0750, 0850 and 0950 journeys from Middlesbrough to Scarborough, and the 1620, 1725 (1720 Sunday) and 1825 (1820 Sunday) journeys from Scarborough to Middlesbrough, each day will be withdrawn. On Monday to Saturday, the 1755 departure from Scarborough will terminate at Whitby whilst the 1820 journey from Middlesbrough will no longer extend beyond Whitby, and the 2020 departure from Middlesbrough to Whitby will be withdrawn. A regular direct service between Middlesbrough and Northallerton will continue to be available on TransPennine Express trains, with connections at Middlesbrough to/from James Cook University Hospital.
